SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That John C. Holland, Daniel J. McCauley and Columbus J. Shipley, are hereby appointed and constituted a board of Examiners and Assessors, with power and authority in them- Board of exselves in case of refusal to act, resignation or death of any of their number to fill such vacancy or vacancies so as always to constitute a board of three, whose duty it shall be to meet at some convenient place as soon as practicable after the passage of this act, for the purpose of making such assessments upon the owners of land lying on or near Wilkins Avenue, for the construction and completion thereof as in their judgment may be benefitted by the construction and completion of the same.
