

## CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT to regulate the fees of the County Surveyor for Garrett county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Surveyor of Garrett county, shall be entitled to charge for his individual services, <sup>Surveyor's fees.</sup> under a warrant of survey or resurvey, directed from the land office, under orders or warrants of resurvey directed from the courts of law, and under orders from courts of equity, a per-diem of five dollars for each day he may necessarily be engaged in performing the duty the said orders or warrants enjoin on the said surveyor, and when the same shall be required by the person for whom the services shall be rendered shall state his account of such services under oath.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect <sup>In force.</sup> from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT to repeal section nine hundred and forty-one of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "water."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section nine hundred and forty-one of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "water," be <sup>Repealed.</sup> and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take <sup>In force.</sup> effect from the date of its passage.
