CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT to repeal the act passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to regulate fences on adjoining lands of persons in Prince George's county."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine and ten of chapters two hundred and seventy-eight of the laws passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 19.
