

CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT to repeal the act passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to regulate fences on adjoining lands of persons in Prince George's county."

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine and ten of chapters two hundred and seventy-eight of the laws passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same are hereby repealed.

In force. SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT to repeal section nine hundred and thirty-five of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "water," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section nine hundred and thirty-five of article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "water," be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted to read as follows:
