Prince Georges County Ss. John Gardiner late of Prince Georges County Cooper was Sumoned to Answer unto our Sovereigne Lord the King that now is and Abraham Field planter who as well for his Majesty as for himselfe in this behalfe procecuteth of a plea that he render unto his Said Majesty and Abraham Field the Sume of three hundred and fifty lbs. of tobaccoe which to his Said Majesty and the Said Abraham Field he oweth and unjustly Deteyneth.
