Then Came James Cobb before us and made oath that he paid to Richard Charlett about five yeare agoe Nine hundred lbs. of tobaccoe upon the Account of William Graves proved before Walter Smith and Francis Hutchings two of his Majesties Justices of the peace for Calvert County as wittness our hands.

Walter Smith: Francis Hutchings.

All which being by the Court here Seen heard and understood it doth appeare the plantiffe to be Indebted to the Defendants Sixteen pounds of tobaccoe. Therefore it is Considered that the Said plantiffe take nothing by his Said writt but be in mercy etc. and that the Said Hugh and Elizabeth goe thereof without day etc. the plantiffe not paying any Cost he being an Administrator etc.
