Whereupon the Said Thomas Vauhun by Joshua Cecell his attorney cometh and Deffendeth the Force and Injury when etc. and Saith that he is not informed by the Said Thomas Vaughun his Client for the Said Thomas Vaughun in the Plea aforesaid and nothing more thereof Saith by which the Said John Hide and Company remaineth against the Said Thomas Vaughun undefended.

Therefore tis Considered that the Said John Hide and Company recover against the Said Thomas Vaughun as well the Sume of five hundred thirty one pounds of Tobacco his Debt aforesaid as allso the Sume of two Hundred and Sixteen pounds of Tobacco to the Said John Hide and Company of their assent by the Court here adjudged and the Said Thomas Vaughun in Mercy.
