Therefore it is Considered that the Said Thomas Wheeler recover against the aforesaid Nicholas Sporne Defendant as well the Sume of Nine hundred pounds of Tobacco his Debt aforesaid unless the Said Nicholas Sporne make appear any be paid of the Said bill dureing the Session of this Court as allso the Sume of two hundred forty and four pounds of Tobacco to the Said Plaintiff of his Assent for his Cost and Charge[s] of Suite by the Court here adjudged and the Said Nicholas Sporne Defendant in mercy.

And the Said Murphey Ward by Joshua Cecell his attorney comes and defends the Force and Injury when etc. and Saith that he did not assume in manner and forme and putts himselfe upon the Court by Consent. Joshua Cecell.

And the Plaintiff allso. William Stone.
