Therefore it is Considered that the Said Charles Tracy doe Recover against the Said David Small his debt for Damages aforesaid and his damages by occasion of deteyning the Said Debt to the Sume of two hundred twenty and two pounds of tobaccoe to the Said plantiffe of his Assent by the Court here Adjudged to be Leavied of the goods and Chattles which were of the Said William Copers att the time of his Death and which to the hands of the Said David Small in time to Come Shall happen to Come to be Administred and the Said David Small in mercy etc.
