III. And be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid may appoint one CHAP. of their number as treasurer, who is hereby enjoined and empowered to collect Who may apand receive all monies subscribed, or that may be subscribed for the purpose of point a trealaying out and clearing the faid roads, and such subscribers are hereby directed to surer, &c. pay their feveral subscriptions to the treasurer appointed as aforesaid; and if any person shall refuse or neglect to pay his subscription money, the said treasurer, or any of the said commissioners in the name of the whole, may and is hereby authorifed to fue for, recover and receive, the same; and the said monies, when received, shall be applied by the said commissioners, or any two of them, to the purposes of this act.

IV. and be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid shall ascertain and And ascertain value what damages may be sustained by persons through whose lands the said damages, &c. roads may pass, by occasion thereof, and in case any proprietor or proprietors, or their guardian or trustee, shall conceive themselves aggrieved by the valuation of the commissioners of the damages to be sustained by opening the said road through their land, that it shall and may be lawful for any justice of the peace for Anne-Arundel county, on application for that purpose by any person interested, to issue his warrant under hand and seal, directed to any constable of said county, commanding him to fummon five freeholders to appear on a day by him to be appointed on the land aforesaid, who on oath shall estimate and value the said damages, and return the same to the said justice of the peace aforesaid, which valuation, so made and returned, shall be conclusive, and the party or parties in whose favour the said valuation shall be made, shall be entitled to receive the same from the said commissioners, and which shall be paid by the said commissioners, within fix months after the faid valuation, out of the subscription money received and collected, to the person or persons, or his, her, or their guardian or guardians, suffering such injury and damage.

V. and be it enacted, That the faid roads shall not go through any orchard, Not to go garden or meadow, unless by and with the consent of the owner thereof.

H A P. III.

An ACT to make valid the proceedings of the commissioners of Passed May the tax for Dorchester county.

HEREAS it appears to this legislature, that the commissioners of the Preamble. tax for Dorchester county were prevented from performing the duties required by the feveral acts of affembly for raifing the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-fix, on the days mentioned in the said acts (by not having received the laws in due time), but that the duties were performed as foon thereafter as was in the power of the faid commissioners;

II. Be it enacted, by the general affembly of Maryland, That all matters and Proceedings proceedings performed by the commissioners aforesaid, in pursuance of the several week. acts of affembly to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eight-six, shall be as effectual and valid as if they had been performed on the days, and at the times, mentioned in the said acts.

III. And, whereas the commissioners aforesaid may be liable to certain fines and forfeitures for not performing fundry duties required to be done and performed by them on the particular days mentioned in the said several acts to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-six, Be it enasted, That the Commission. commissioners aforesaid are exonerated, saved harmless and discharged, from all ers exonerated, saved harmless and discharged, saved harmless and discharged harmle fines, forfeitures and penalties, which they have incurred, in all matters relating to the faid several acts to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-fix.
