XXI. and, to prevent individuals from being unreasonably burthened with C II A P. the execution of this act, as trustees for the poor, Be it enacted, That at the Two trustees time of the meeting of the said trustees for the poor in the first week of Novem-to be crossen ber yearly, the faid trustees, or the major part of them, in the county aforesaid, annually, &c. shall and may elect and choose two of the inhabitants of the said county to be trustees for the poor of that county, in the stead of the first two named or eldest of the faid trustees of the same county; which said first named or eldest trustees shall be, and is by virtue hereof, thencefrom discharged from their office.

XXII. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the trustees Trustees to aforesaid, or the major part of them, to rent an house or houses in the said counrent an house,
ty for the recention of such poor regrents, regeleade or asked on the said coun&c. ty, for the reception of fuch poor, vagrants, vagabonds, or other offenders, with the necessary lot or lots of ground adjoining to such house or houses, as convenient to the court-house as may be in the same county, for the reception and accommodation of the faid poor, vagrants, vagabonds, and other offenders, until a furficient sum of money be raised in virtue of this act, to enable the said tru tees to purchase the land and erect the buildings herein before mentioned; and the justices of said county are hereby empowered and enjoined annually, at the court for laying the county rate, to affefs on the taxable property of the faid county, a furficient fum to discharge the rent aforesaid, with the collector's commission of fix per cent. thereon; which fum so as aforesaid affested, shall be collected and paid by the faid collector to the faid trustees, or the major part of them, to be by them applied to the purposes aforesaid; and the said trustees, or the major part of them, are hereby empowered and required, as foon as such house or houses aforesaid are procured on rent, to proceed to the appointment of an overfeer, and other officers and fervants as are mentioned in this act, and to do and perform every other matter and thing necessary to the carrying the said act into execution, according to the true intent and meaning thereof.

## C H A P. XV. An ACT for the relief of the poor of Queen-Anne's county.

Paffed De-

HEREAS many of the inhabitants of Queen-Anne's county, by their Preamble, humble petition to this general affembly, have fet forth, that the taxes for the support of the poor of their county are very heavy and burthensome, but are, notwithstanding, under the present regulation, inadequate to the comfortable subfiftence of said poor; that a work-house has become neceffery for the reception and employment of beggars, vagrants and vagabonds; and that the free-school of the said county does not answer the purposes of its inflitution; and have therefore prayed, that an act may pass to appropriate the faid free-school, with the land and funds belonging to the same, to the use of an alms and work-house for the faid county.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the free-school Property vestproperty of the faid county, of what nature foever, and the funds appropriated &c. to the use thereof, be and are hereby vested in the trustees within named, and their fuccessors, and shall be taken and held by them for the use and as funds for the relief and support of the poor of said county; and the visitors of the freeschool in the said county are hereby authorised, required and directed, to deliver to the faid trustees all the free-school property aforesaid, and to render unto them a full and just account of the profits thereof, and also of any sum or sums of money or tobacco which may be owing to the faid school; and if there shall be any money or tobacco owing to the faid school, the visitors shall, and are hereby required, to draw an order or orders for the same to the said trustees, and their fuccessors, for the uses and purposes aforesaid.

III. and, whereas there are buildings upon the faid land which may be repaired and converted into alms and work-houses, and others which may be judged necessary by the said trustees for the purposes in this act mentioned may be erected and built on the faid land, at a moderate expence, and the fame ought to be effected at the general charge of the faid county, Be it enacted, That the Justices to levy money,
