and confent of the council, to appoint and commission another person to supply CHAP. fuch vacancy, and the person so commissioned, after qualifying himself in the manner prescribed by the said first recited act, shall have and exercise the same power and authority as any other justice of the orphans court.

IV. This act to continue and remain in force until the end of the next session Continuance. of affembly.

## H A P. LIX.

An ACT to continue the acts of affembly therein mentioned. E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act, entitled, Three acts An act to ascertain the allowance to the members of the general assembly continued. to defray the expence of their attendance, passed April session, seventeen hundred and eighty-feven, be and is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, and to the end of the next session of affembly that shall happen thereafter. That another act of affembly, entitled, An act for the regulation of officers fees, passed November session, seventeen hundred and seventy-nine, and one other act for the regulation of officers sees, and for other purposes, passed October session, seventeen hundred and eighty, shall be and they are hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, and until the end of the next session of assembly that shall happen thereafter.

II. And be it enacted, That instead of the poundage fees allowed to the sheriff Poundage fees by the faid first mentioned act, he be allowed only at the rate of seven and a half afcertained, and several per cent. for the first ten pounds in money, or one thousand pounds of tobacco, and acts continuthe rate of three per cent. for the refidue, in the fame species the execution shall ed. iffue for; and that where execution or attachment shall be made on lands held for years, or a greater estate, only one half of the poundage fees, but if the estate in the land shall not be chargeable by appraisement, and delivered to the plaintiff, or by fale of the sheriff, one quarter part of the poundage sees only shall be chargeable. That another act of assembly, entitled, An act to continue the acts of affembly therein mentioned, paffed October fession, seventeen hundred and eighty, to prevent the exportation of flour, staves and shingles, not merchantable, from the town of Baltimore, in Baltimore county, and to regulate the weights of hav, and the measure of grain, salt, flax-seed and firewood, within the said town, and to prevent the exportation of flour not merchantable from Fell's Point, in the faid county, made at a fession of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the fecond day of October, seventeen hundred and seventy-one, shall be and is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October, seventeen hundred and ninety-feven, and until the end of the next fession of assembly that shall happen That another act of affembly, entitled, An act to continue an act, entitled, An act for the relief of infolvent debtors, passed March session, seventeen hundred and seventy-four, be and is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, and until the end of the next fession of assembly that shall happen thereaster. That another act of assembly, entitled, An act to prevent disabled and superannuated slaves being set free, or the manumission of slaves by any last will or testament, passed June session, seventeen hundred and fifty-two, except such parts thereof as are repealed by an act, entitled, An act to prevent disabled and superannuated slaves being set free, or the manumission of slaves by any last will and testament, and of a supplementary act thereto, and for certain other purposes, passed this session of assembly, be and is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October, seventeen hundred and ninety-feven, and to the end of the next fession of assembly that shall happen thereafter. And that another act of affembly, entitled, An act for the more effectual punishment of criminals, passed at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Monday the second of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine, excepting only as to the time of holding the court in November, which shall be on the third Tuesday instead of the second, be and is hereby continued until the first day of January, seventeen hundred and ninety-two.
