county, on application by any person interested, to iffue his warrant, under hand City P. and feal, directed to any constable of the county, commanding him to jummon five freeholders, difinterested as to the said road, to appear, on a day by him to be appointed, on the land of the person making application as aforefuld; and the faid freeholders shall respectively repair to some magistrate of the said county, and take the following oath, or affirmation, to wit: "I, A. B. do fwear, or foleran'v, " fincerely and truly declare and affirm, that I will honeftly and faithfully estimate and value the damage and injury sustained by C. D. by opening a " road through the land of the said C. D. in pursuance of the directions of this " act;" and shall return the damages by them assessed to the said justice of the peace, and the damages, so assessed and returned, shall be conclusive; and the party or parties, in whose favour the valuation ascertained by the Lid commissioners, or the damages affessed by the said freeholders, shall be made, shall be entitled to receive the same from the said commissioners; and the said commissioners shall pay, or secure to be paid, the amount of the said valuation, or damages, to the respective parties entitled to receive the same, out of the monies to be raifed and collected from the subscriptions to the said road, within the space of fix months after the afcertainment of fuch valuation, or damages, and before they shall proceed to affect the lands and tenements of the person or persons concerned; provided, that the faid road shall not go through any houses, gardens, meadows or orehards, unless with the consent of the owner thereof.

C H A P. XV.

An ACT to enable the select vestry of Saint-Michael's parish, in Parish Teacher 27.

Talbot county, and James Tilghman, of Chester-town, in Kent county, to make an exchange of certain lands.

HEREAS the felect veitry of Saint-Michael's parish, in Talbot Preables county, and James Tilghman, of Chefter-town, in Kent county, have represented to this general assembly, by their petition and memorial, that the said select vestry are seized and possessed, in see-simple, of a plantation, consisting of glebe lands belonging to the said parish, lying chiefly on the south side of a creek, in the said parish, called Fausbey Creek, but partly on the north side of the same, and the branches thereof; and the said James Tilghaman is seized and possessed, in see-simple, of an adjoining plantation, lying chiefly on the north side of the said creek, and the branches thereof, but purey on the south side of the said creek, and by roads running through them, as, in their present situation, to be very inconvenient to the owners and possessor, but may be rendered commodious and convenient by an exchange of parts of the said plantations and lands; and this general assembly, upon due consideration, having determined the said application to be reasonable and proper,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Muryland, That the select vestry seed vestry, of the said parish for the time being, and the said James Tilghman, shall, by virtue of this act, be enabled and empowered to make such exchange of parts of &c. the said lands and plantations, as the said select vestry, or a majority of them, and the said James Tilghman, may think commodious and convenient to their several plantations aforesaid respectively, and to make and execute proper deeds for the lands exchanged, to be acknowledged and recorded according to the laws of this state; of which lands so taken in exchange respectively, the said select vestry, and the said James Tilghman, shall, by virtue of such deeds and this act, be seized in see-simple, the said select vestry to them and their successors, and the said James Tilghman to him and his heirs and assigns, for ever.
