EXPLANATORY NOTE:

Column (1) represents the percentage of votes received by candidates of the following parties in the years indicated: 1789, Anti-Federalist; 1792, no votes listed; 1796 - 1820, Democratic-Republican; 1824 - 1828, Andrew Jackson; 1832 - 1980, Democrat.

Column (2) represents the percentage of votes received by candidates of the following parties in the years indicated: 1789 - 1820, Federalists; 1824, John Quincy Adams; 1828 - 1832, National-Republican; 1836 - 1852, Whig; 1856 - 1980, Republican.

Column (3) represents the percentage of votes received by all other candidates and parties not reflected in Columns (1) and (2). The Vote Maps in Appendix A for each presidential election may be utilized to determine the percentage of votes for the candidates and parties.

The symbol "*" means that the subdivision was not in existence during the relevant election year.

The symbol "-" means that no votes were cast for the designated party in the subdivision during the relevant election year.

The use of "0.0" means that votes were cast for the designated party in the subdivision during the relevant election year but the number of votes cast did not compute to one-tenth of a percent.
