NATIONAL ELECTION RETURNS

Monroe and Tompkins	231 electoral votes
John Quincy Adams (NR)	1—supposedly to preserve for Washington the honor of having received the only unanimous electoral vote.

MISCELLANEA

President Monroe's second term was not so tranquil and at the end, the country was in political turmoil largely because Monroe did not want to hurt feelings of any of his friends by supporting only one of them as his successor.

When he died on July 4, 1831 — the third President to die on July 4 — John Quincy Adams noted, ". . . his Administration . . . was a time of great prosperity, and his personal popularity was unrivalled. Yet no one regretted the termination of his Administration, and less of popular veneration followed him into retirement than had accompanied all his predecessors . . ."
