Whereupon the President delivered one of the said Certificates to Hon. Wm. Shephard Bryan (one of the Electors) to be by him deposited in the Post office in the City of Annapolis and another of the said Certificates to Hon. Charles G. Kerr (another of the Electors) to be by him conveyed and delivered to the Judge of the District Court of the United States for the District of Maryland.

On motion of Mr. Raine the following form of Credential was read and adopted:

State of Maryland to Wit.

To all persons whom it may concern
Know ye that in the Election of President and Vice President of the United States of America, duly elected in and for the State of Maryland having met at the City of Annapolis on this day provided by the Constitution and Laws of the United States to perform the trust reposed in us and having voted and made out in due form Certificates and lists of the votes given and the persons voted for and having deposited in Augustus Sweeney of Anne Arundel County, here appointed and by these presents do appoint and authorize him to take charge of any of said Certificates and list and with all convenient dispatch to convey and deliver the same to the President of the Senate of the United States at Washington.
