

Annapolis Md Jan 24<sup>th</sup> 1859

The Electors re-assembled in the State House on Thursday January 24<sup>th</sup> and having before them the sealed certificates and lists of the votes for President and Vice President of the United States prepared on the second Monday and fourteenth day of January instant, enclosed thereon the following memorandum, signed by each Elector.

Maryland Annapolis, Oct.

We the Electors of the State of Maryland, President and Vice President of the United States do hereby certify that the lists of all the votes of the State of Maryland given for President, and of all the votes of said State given for Vice President, are contained in this certificate;



One of the certificates was then given to Mr Combs, one of the Electors, to be deposited in the Post Office at Annapolis directed to "The President of the Senate of the United States at the Seat of Government Washington D.C.", One to Mr Moale, one of the Electors, to be by him conveyed and delivered to "The Judge of the District Court of the United States for the District of Maryland, And the remaining one to Mr W. G. Arnell Secretary of the College to be by him conveyed and delivered to the President of the Senate of the United States at Washington D.C.

The purpose for which the Electors re-assembled, was accomplished by the above proceedings.
