To all persons whom it may Concern: Know ye that we the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America, duly elected in and for the State of Maryland having met at the City of Annapolis on the day prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the United States to perform the trust reposed in us, and having ~~and~~ made out in due form certificates and lists of the votes given, and the persons voted for, and having confidence in the bearer Mr. J. Furnell Secretary to the College, have appointed, and by these presents do appoint and authorize him to take charge of one of said certificates and lists, and with all convenient dispatch to convey and deliver the same to the President of the Senate of the United States at Washington. In witness whereof we herewith set our hands and seals this ninth day of January Eighteen-hundred and ninety-three.
