Chapman, Edward H. Calvert, Edward Johnson, John McMillen, Henry Williams, Samuel Rantch, Tobias L. Stensbury, Moses W. Beading, Thomas W. Wood, Edward Dwyer, and Littleton Dennis Esquires are duly elected Electors, on the part of this State, to choose a President and Vice President of the United States.

Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the Great Seal of the State of Maryland this Twenty-fourth day of September in the year of our Lords the thousand, eight hundred and one hundred.
