Senate Chamber, Annapolis, Md., Jan., 15th. 1921
 To All Whom It May Concern:

Know Ye, that we, the Electors of the President and Vice President of the United States of America, duly elected in and for the State of Maryland, having met at the City of Annapolis, on the day prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, to perform the trust reposed in us, and having made out in due form certificates and lists of the votes given, and the persons voted for, and having confidence in the honor, Chas. J. Taylor, Esq., has appointed, and by these presents do appoint, and authorize him to take charge of our said certificates and lists, and with all convenient dispatch to convey and deliver the same to the President of the Senate of the United States at Washington.

In Witness whereof we hereunto set our hands and seals this 15th day of January, Nineteen Hundred Twenty one.
