

State of Maryland.

We, the undersigned, Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States of America for the respective terms beginning on the fourth day of March A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, being Electors duly and legally appointed and qualified by and for the State of Maryland, as appears by the annexed certificate made and delivered to us by the Executive of the said State, having met and convened, agreeably to the provisions of law, at Annapolis in said State of Maryland, on the second Monday in January of the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, being the 2^d day of said month,

By Verbal Act, that being so assembled and duly organized we proceeded to vote by ballot, and tallied first for President and then for Vice-President by distinct ballot.

And by further Act, that the following are the distinct lists, one of the votes for President, and the other of the votes for Vice-President so cast as aforesaid.

List of All Persons Voted upon for President.
Calvin Coolidge eight votes.

List of All Persons Voted upon for Vice-President.
Charles E. Darrow eight votes.
