 States of America.

That we then, proceeded to vote by distinct ballots, for
 Vice President of the United States of America, and upon counting
 the ballots, it was ascertained, that






John Tyler,

 of the United States of America.

 said, are hereby returned by us, the electors of President and Vice
 President of the United States of America, in and for the State of Ohio

 States, as having the aforesaid number of votes.
