To All Persons Whom it may concern.

Know ye, that we the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America, duly elected in and for the State of Maryland, having met at the City of Annapolis, on the day prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the United States to perform the Trust reposed in us, and having voted, and made out in due form Lists of the votes given, and the Persons voted for; and having conferred in

Counsil, of the City of Annapolis, have appointed, and, by these presents, do appoint and authorize him to take charge of one of said Lists, and, with all convenient despatch, deliver the same to the President of the Senate of the United States at Washington.
