

XI. And he it enacted, that the said Electors shall receive the same fee and allowances and itinerant charges, as are allowed to Members of the General Assembly.

XII. And whereas it may happen, that in the election of Representatives, two or more persons, residing in the same District, may have an equal number of votes, and that in the election of Electors resident of the Western Shore, six or more persons, residing at that Shore may have an equal number of votes, and that in the election of Electors residing on the Eastern Shore, four or more persons, residing at that Shore may have an equal number of votes: Be it enacted, that in each of the said cases, the Governor and Council shall determine by lot from the Candidates, residing in the same District, the Representatives for that District, and in the same manner from the candidates for Electors residing on the Western and Eastern Shores, respectively, having an equal number of votes as aforesaid. That Electors, for the said three.

XIII. And he it enacted, that if a vacancy or vacancies, shall happen in the representation of this State in the House of Representatives in the Congress of the United States, by death, resignation, disqualification or otherwise, the Governor and Council shall issue writs of Election to the several Counties of this State, the City of Annapolis, and Baltimore Town to fill such vacancy or vacancies by the election of a Representative or Representatives, residing in the District or Districts where such vacancy or vacancies shall happen, in the manner herein before presented.

XIV. And he it enacted, that after the elections, herein before mentioned, shall have been made, the election of Representatives to Congress shall be held in manner aforesaid on the first Monday of October in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety, and on the same day in every second year from thenceforth, and elections there of shall be made as aforesaid; and the Governor and Council, for the time being, shall, as soon as convenient, maybe, transmit a certificate of the election of the said Representatives, under the Seal of this State, to the President of the United States.
