plans and specifications for road and bridge work, and such other matters as he deems pertinent. In connection with his other duties, the said superintendent shall act as clerk to the said Board of County Road Commissioners. The said superintendent of public roads shall be paid by the Board of County Road Commissioners the annual salary of fifteen hundred doland expenses lars, in quarterly payments, and also be allowed for his actual expenses in performance of his duties, for which sworn vouchers must be filed with the clerk of the County Commissioners, provided the same do not exceed the sum of four hundred dollars annually.

Powers granted.

285. The Board of County Road Commissioners shall be the agents of the Board of County Commissioners of Prince George's County, for the purposes and with the powers and privileges hereby granted, and none other. They shall have the general supervision and control of all public roads and bridges and the buildings and repairs of the same; they shall purchase and distribute the necessary implements, tools, machinery and materials therefor, and perform such other duties as may be necessary to secure an efficient administration of the public road system, subject to the provisions of this Article. to all public roads and bridges and all material, machinery, tools and implements procured as above shall be vested in the County Commissioners of Prince George's County, and all contracts that the said Board of County Road Commissioners may be authorized to make shall be in its name as agents of County Commissioners of Prince George's County.

Annual levytaking term.

286. The County Commissioners of Prince George's County shall annually, at their regular annual levy-taking term, levy upon the assessable property of the county a tax of not less than twenty cents on the hundred dollars, which shall be for the repairs and reconstruction of the public roads and bridges in said county; said amount of money shall be paid one-half before the fifteenth day of July, and one-half on or before the fifteenth day of September of the year of their levy, to the order of the Board of County Road Commissioners, and said tax shall be levied and collected as other county taxes. The said County Commissioners may appropriate and levy such other sum or sums of money as they may think needful for the building of new bridges, the opening of new roads, and the repairs and reconstruction of highways and bridges; and the same shall be paid over to the Board of County Road Commissioners, to be disbursed by them under terms of appropriation.
