in the Clerk's office of the Circuit Court for Allegany County, to be therein recorded among the land records of said county, and the voters residing in said district shall be entitled to the same rights and privileges as voters in other districts in said county, and the said Board of Election Supervisors shall appoint such officers of registration and election required in such district as are necessary under the laws of the State of Maryland.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 67.

AN ACT to refund to the Montgomery County Telephone Company, Gaithersburg, Maryland, a certain amount of county taxes paid in error.

To refund county taxes

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Commissioners of Montgomery County be paid in error, and they are hereby requested and directed to pay to the Montgomery County Telephone Company, of Gaithersburg, Maryland, the sum of ninety-seven dollars and ninety-nine cents, being the amount of over payment of county taxes paid in error by said Montgomery County Telephone Company in the years 1809, 1900, 1901 and 1902.

> Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT to provide for the deficiency in the payment of census enumerators under Chapter 3 of the Acts of the General Assembly at the Extraordinary Session of 1901.

WHEREAS, The sum of forty thousand dollars appropriated under Chapter 3 of the Acts of the Extraordinary Session of pay for cen-1901 for the payment of census enumerators was inadequate for the full payment of certain enumerators, the character of whose work was such as to make the payment for fifteen days provided for in said Act insufficient for the just compensation of said enumerators: and.
