

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

CHAPTER 627.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Talbot County, in the State of Maryland, and the Commissioners of the town of Oxford, in their discretion, to construct a drawbridge across Town creek, in said county, at the foot of Market street, in the town of Oxford, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to pay for constructing the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Talbot County and the Commissioners of the town of Oxford be and they are hereby empowered to construct a drawbridge across Town creek, in the town of Oxford, in said county, at a point at the foot of Market street, in the said town.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said County Commissioners and Commissioners of the town of Oxford are hereby authorized and empowered to levy upon the assessable property of Talbot County and the town of Oxford a tax sufficient to pay the cost of constructing said drawbridge.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 628.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the maintenance of the Fifth Regiment Armory.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That for the purpose of maintaining the Fifth Regiment Armory until the thirtieth of September, 1906, the sum of four thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be necessary; and the Treasurer of the State, on warrant of the Comptroller, shall disburse the said sum to and upon the order of the board of trustees of the Fifth Regiment Armory for the purpose herein specified.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, 1904.
