

50B. Any person catching or taking fish contrary to the provisions of the preceding section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace of said county, shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars; one-half thereof shall be paid to the informer, and the other half to the County Commissioners of Wicomico County.

Violating provision a misdemeanor.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 634.

AN ACT to exempt from taxation the real and personal property and the capital stock of the Trinity Church Guild of Baltimore County, a body corporate, so long as said property is used for charitable or benevolent purposes.

WHEREAS, It is represented to the General Assembly of Maryland that the Trinity Church Guild of Baltimore County is a corporation incorporated primarily for the purpose of purchasing and owning property in the village of Towson, to be rented at a nominal rental to the Guild of Trinity Church, a religious organization, and that subscriptions to the capital stock of said corporation have been made from charitable motives, and not for the purpose of profit or gain; therefore,

Trinity Church Guild of Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the property, real and personal, of the capital stock of the Trinity Church Guild of Baltimore County, a corporation, be and the same is hereby declared exempt from county taxation so long as and to the extent that such property is used for the purpose stated in the preamble to this Act.

Exempting stock and property from taxation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 635.

AN ACT to amend the Act of 1896, Chapter 173, entitled "An Act to change the name of the Brooklyn Water and Light Company of Anne Arundel County, and to amend, define and enlarge the powers of said corporation," by repealing and re-enacting with amendments Section 6 thereof.
