

lected, and when collected shall be applied to the payment of said bonds as they mature, and the interest thereon, semi-annually.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to employ all servants and agents, and to make all contracts, and to do all acts necessary to carry the provisions of this Act into effect. Empowering Commissioners to employ labor, etc.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 642.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 426 of the Acts of 1898, entitled "An Act to extend the corporate limits of the City of Cumberland, Maryland, and to provide for the extension of Washington street to said limits as extended, and for the grading, paving, and otherwise improving said Washington street as extended, and Brook avenue lying within the present city limits and contiguous to said proposed extension," and to enact the following in lieu thereof: "An Act to extend the corporate limits of the City of Cumberland and to provide for the extension, laying off, grading, paving and otherwise improving of Washington street from the west side of lot No. 72 (in Read's addition to the City of Cumberland) in a westerly direction about twenty-one hundred feet to Sulphur Springs Hollow road, at a point to be determined by the Commissioners appointed under this Act."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the city limits of Cumberland, Maryland, as now constituted, be and the same are hereby extended so as to include all that body of land lying westward of the fourteenth line of the present city limits and described generally, as follows: Beginning at a point on the fourteenth city line (as surveyed by William Brace the 7th day of May, 1868, and recorded in Liber No. 27, folio 222, one of the Land Records of Allegany County) distant two hundred and fifty feet, measured in a northeasterly direction from the center of Fayette street extended, otherwise known as Sulphur Springs Hollow road, and running thence in a westerly direction par- Extending city limits of Cumberland, Md.
