Caroline
County—
Roads.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 205 to 213, both inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "Roads;" Sections 1 and 2 of Article 25 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," and all other laws, so far as said sections and laws may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following be enacted in lieu thereof, as sections of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "Roads."

County Com-
missioners to
control roads
and bridges.

205. The County Commissioners of Caroline County are authorized and empowered to control and regulate the public roads and bridges in said county, subject to the provisions of this Act.

Levy to be
made.

206. The County Commissioners of Caroline County shall, at the time of making their annual levy, levy upon the taxable property of said county a tax of not less than twenty cents on the hundred dollars, which shall be used for the repair and reconstruction of public roads and bridges in said county, which taxes shall be levied and collected as are other county taxes.

To appropriate
moneys for
building
roads and
bridges.

The said County Commissioners may appropriate or levy such other sum or sums of money as they may deem requisite for building of new bridges and opening of new roads, and for repairing and reconstructing public roads and bridges in said county. All of the taxes levied and collected under the provisions of this section shall be disbursed by the said County Commissioners upon the roads and bridges in said county and in the manner hereinafter provided, and in no other.

Appointment
of competent
party to make
surveys, plats,
etc.

207. The County Commissioners of Caroline County shall, within sixty days after this Act becomes operative, as hereinafter provided for, appoint some competent person, who shall have a sufficient knowledge of civil engineering to enable him to accurately make surveys, plats, profiles and specifications for the grading, draining, maintenance, repairs and reconstruction of the public roads of said county, and also to do the necessary engineering work for the building or rebuilding of bridges, and who shall have had at least three years' experience in engineering work of County Road Engineer for Caroline County, at a salary not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars a year, pay-
