5. The said Hagerstown Railway Company of Washington County, Maryland, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to buy, sell, lease or consolidate with the Hagerstown and Myersville Railway Company and the Hagerstown West End Railway Company or either of them, two corporations duly incorporated under the incorporation laws of the State of Maryland, and also to buy, sell, lease or consolidate with or enter into any traffic arrangement with any other railroad or railway company, and the said Hagerstown and Myersville Railway Company and the said Hagerstown West End Railway Company, or either of them, shall have and exercise the right to sell, lease to or consolidate with or enter into a traffic agreement with the said Hagerstown Railway Company of Washington County, Maryland, or any other railroad or railway company.

Charter made

6. The charter of the Hagerstown Railway Company of Washington County, Maryland, be and the same is hereby made perpetual.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 65i.

AN ACT to prevent the hauling of seines in certain waters of Anne Arundel County.

Preventing
seine hauling
in certain

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to haul seine in any creek, river or other waters in Anne Arundel County where the shores of the opposite sides of said creek, river or other waters are less than twenty-five yards apart, and seine hauling is hereby prohibited within one hundred yards of the head of any creek, river or other waters within the boundaries of Anne Arundel County.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person or persons offending against the provisions of this Act, upon conviction before any justice of the peace in Anne Arundel County, who are hereby given jurisdiction in such offenses, shall be fined not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each and every offense, provided that the party convicted shall have the right to appeal to the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County.
