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CHAPTER 652.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 105 of Article 24 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Fox Hunters."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 105 of Article 24 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Fox Hunters," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows: Fox hunting.

105. Any person who shall be convicted of pursuing any fox in said county with dogs between the tenth day of March and the first day of September, in each year, or who shall be convicted of shooting any fox whilst pursued by dogs in said county shall be liable to a fine of five dollars for each and every offense, to be recovered before any justice of the peace of said county as other small debts are recoverable. Certain restrictions on fox hunters.

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CHAPTER 653.

AN ACT to prevent deception in the manufacture and sale of vinegar, and adding certain new sections to Article 43 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," to follow Section 51, and to be known as Sections 51A, 51B, 51C, 51D, 51E, 51F.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That certain new sections be and the same are hereby added to Article 43 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," to be known as Sections 51A, 51B, 51C, 51D, 51E, 51F. Health.
