corporate, and the said body corporate shall have power to act as the fiscal or transfer agent of any States, municipality, body politic or corporate, and in such capacity to receive and disburse money, and transfer, register and countersign certificates of stock, bonds or other evidences of debt, and may receive and manage any sinking fund for any corporation.

Power to consolidate with similar corporations.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That said body corporate shall have power to consolidate with any other corporation or corporations having like or similar powers upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the majority of the stockholders of each of the corporations assenting thereto, and the consolidated company shall have all the powers and privileges of the companies so consolidated, and shall have such name and such capital stock as shall be agreed upon between the same; and when such consolidation is made a certificate of the consolidation and the particulars thereof shall be executed by the said corporations and be acknowledged and recorded.

Subject to certain provisions.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That said body corporate shall be subject at all times to the provisions of the Act of 1892, Chapters 109 and 279, and to the Acts of 1896, Chapter 160, and all supplements or amendments thereto.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 680.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Barnesville, in Montgomery County.

To incorporate the town of Barnesville, Montgomery County.

SECTION 1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the citizens of the town of Barnesville, in Montgomery County, be and they are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Commissioners of Barnesville," with all the powers and privileges of a body politic and corporate, and by said corporate name may have perpetual succession, sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in court of law or equity, and may have and use a corporate seal.

Corporate limits of the town.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the corporate limits of the town shall be as follows: Commencing near a large oak tree standing on the east side of the public road leading from Barnesville to Barnesville station, and running in a northeasterly direction with the northern boundary of the property of John
