To the following devises and bequests under the last will and testament of Margaretha Deck, deceased, bearing date November 13, 1893, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore City, in Liber T. W. M. No. 71, folio 132, etc. (a) A devise and bequest after disposing of certain portions of her property, one-half of the residue and remainder of her estate unto the reverend parish rector or pastor of the Fourteen Holy Martyrs Church. (b) A devise and bequest of the other one-half of the residue and remainder unto the pastor or rector, for the time being, of the Roman Catholic Church, in her native place, Munchemsdor, Laudgericht, Burgeherach, in Bavaria, in the Empire of Germany, absolutely, both the expended, as set forth in said will.
