SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the said bonds authorized and directed to be issued by this Act shall be sold by the said County Commissioners and under the direction of the Commissioners herein named and appointed, for not less than the par value thereof, and any accrued interest thereon, the proceeds to be deposited in some safe and reliable banking institution in Somerset County to be designated on the books of the County Commissioners as "The Court House Fund," and to be applied to the payment of the expenses incurred in building a court house, vaults and offices for the Clerk of the Circuit Court, Orphans' Court, County Commissioners, School Commissioners, State's Attorney, Sheriff and County Treasurer as hereinbefore provided, but no part of the proceeds of said bonds, or any money levied and assessed by the said County Commissioners for the purpose of constructing the said court house and offices and furnishing the same shall be payable unless upon the order of the Commissioners hereby appointed to contract for and superintend the building and furnishing of the said court house, or their successors or a majority of them.

Annual levy.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Somerset County shall annually levy upon the assessable property of said county a tax sufficient to pay the interest due on such bonds as shall be issued under the provisions of this Act, and in the year 1924 they shall levy the sum of five hundred dollars to meet the first maturing bonds issued, that is to say, the five hundred dollars maturing in the year 1925 and annually thereafter, the said County Commissioners shall levy upon said assessable property the sum of five hundred dollars until the maturity of the last bond hereby authorized to be issued, and said levy shall be designated as "Revenue for the Bonded Indebtedness of 1904 for Court House."

Exempt from  
all taxes.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the bonds hereby authorized shall be exempted from all county and municipal taxes, and that coupons for interest thereon shall be received by the County Treasurer in payment of county taxes.

Bonds to be  
registered  
when sold.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the clerk of the Board of County Commissioners shall register the said bonds when they are sold, showing to whom sold and what price was obtained therefor, the date of the bonds so respectively sold, and shall make a note upon the books of the said County Commissioners of all bonds paid.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That when the building and furnishing of the said court house is completed, the Com-
