CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT to provide for a general index of the Equity Records of Allegany County from the year 1816 to July 1, 1904.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-General Inland, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany County, dex of Maryland, be and he is hereby authorized to make a general Equity Records. index of the Equity Records of said county from the year 1816 to July 1, 1904.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners of Allegany County be and they are hereby authorized and required to levy upon the assessable property of said county, Levy on propas other county charges are levied, a sum sufficient to pay for said indexing, unless the receipts from said Clerk's office shall be enough to pay for said work after all his office expenses and salaries are paid.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Became a law by limitation February 26, 1904.

CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT to incorporate the Camden Sewer Company, of Salisbury, Md.

WHEREAS, By an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Salisbury, Wicomico County, Maryland, passed by said Council on the 7th day of July, 1902, and approved by said Mayor on the 10th day of the same month, William J. Staton, L. E. Williams, N. T. Fitch and A. A. Gillis, and the other persons whom they should associate with themselves in the furnishing of the means for the construction of such sewers, were granted leave and permission to lay a main sewer pipe on Camden avenue (in said Salisbury) from the south end thereof to the Wicomico river (with pipe of not less than twelve inches in diameter), and with the right to lay subsidiary pipes (of same. not less than eight inches in diameter), on any or either of the streets or boulevards, crossing, or intersecting, or convenient to said main sewer that the said persons might deem it advantageous to do; with the right to impose and charge such fee (not over \$75.00) as they should deem best, for the connection by any owner or tenant of any residence or other building, with either of the sewers so to be constructed by them, the said persons and their associates; and with the right to make or allow to be made necessary excavations for
