

- No. 122. An Act to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Caroline County to organize a high school to be located in the town of Federalsburg, in said county, and to appropriate certain moneys in the maintenance thereof. 215
- No. 123. An Act to make valid deeds, mortgages, bonds of conveyance and bills of sale defective in the acknowledgment or in the certificate thereof. 216
- No. 124. An Act to make valid and binding certain interest-bearing certificates of indebtedness heretofore used by the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County, and to add an additional section to Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be designated Section 124A, authorizing the issue by the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County of interest-bearing certificates 217
- No. 125. An Act to authorize and empower the Mayor and Common Council of Hyattsville to establish, construct and maintain a sewerage system for the town of Hyattsville, Prince George's County, and to issue and sell its bonds to the amount of not exceeding \$30,000. To provide funds for that purpose and to provide for the payment of the principal and interest thereof, and to repeal only for the purpose of this Act, Sections 18 and 35 of Chapter 631 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1902, and all Acts and parts of Acts relating to the Mayor and Common Council of Hyattsville as far as the same are in conflict with this Act. 218
- No. 126. An Act to incorporate the Peninsula Produce Exchange of Maryland. 223
- No. 127. An Act to appropriate a sum of money to erect in St. Anne's Cemetery, in the city of Annapolis, a monument to the memory of Thomas G. Pratt, late Governor of Maryland; and also to place in the executive chamber in said city a portrait of the said Governor. 226
- No. 129. An Act placing at the disposal of the Board of Public Works of this State, Hon. Thos. H. Robinson, chairman of the Finance Committee of the Senate of Maryland, and the Hon. Edward G. Goslin, chairman of the Ways and Means Committee of the House of Delegates of Maryland, the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars for the relief of cases of destitution and need caused by the fire in Baltimore of February 7 and 8, 1904; and for the payment out of said money of the militia of the State who were called out for service in Baltimore immediately after said fire. 227
- No. 130. An Act to authorize the Mayor and Council of Rockville to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding five thousand dollars, to pay an indebtedness incurred by the Mayor and Council of Rockville in repairing and enlarging its water system, and for the purpose of restoring and equipping its electric light plant 228
