- No. 457. An Act to repeal Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 509 of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session, 1902, and to re-enact the same with amendments and to make valid official acts of the Mayor and City Council of Ocean City, and of either of them, since the passage of the said Chapter 509 of the Acts of 1902. .... 779
- No. 458. An Act to amend the charter of The Baltimore County Water and Electric Company of Baltimore County by increasing its powers, giving it perpetual existence and extending its electric business to Howard County. .... 781
- No. 459. An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 116E of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Treasurer," as amended by Chapter 477 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1900. .... 782
- No. 460. An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 4 of Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title Exemptions," as repealed and re-enacted by Chapter 120 of the Acts of 1806. .... 782
- No. 461. An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 56A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace". .... 784
- No. 462. An Act to further amend the charter of the Ridgley Savings Bank of Caroline County, Maryland, and to change the name of the same. .... 785
- No. 463. An Act to empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to make appropriations for certain purposes out of any unappropriated balance of the sum of four million four hundred and twenty-two thousand four hundred and sixty dollars and seventy-four cents, forming part of the purchase price paid by the Fuller Syndicate for the interests of the City of Baltimore in the Western Maryland Railroad Company, and heretofore passed to the credit of the General Sinking Fund of said city, and the interest accumulated or to accumulate thereon. .... 786
- No. 464. An Act to repeal Section 1 of Article 76 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Publication of Laws," and to re-enact the same with amendments. .... 787
- No. 465. An Act to repeal Sections 188 to 217E, inclusive, of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Roads," as amended and re-enacted by Chapter 685 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1900, and as subsequently amended by Chapter 524 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1902, and to enact in lieu thereof; the whole to provide for a new road system in Baltimore County and the placing of the public highways, sewers and drains of said county and all matters in connection therewith under the care and control of the
