

221. No such schools shall be opened without the written application to the trustees of said school of at least thirty (30) persons of the age required of students in such night schools. Number of pupils.

222. The teachers or persons appointed by the School Commissioners shall make all necessary arrangements at the different schools for supplying the books required and for lighting the building. Books, etc.

223. Such teachers shall be paid out of the public school fund of Allegany County such compensation and at such times as the School Commissioners aforesaid may be designated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 91.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 27 of Chapter 157 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1902, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 27 and 28 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Caroline County, sub-title 'Birds and Game,' and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add a new section to said Article, and to follow Section 27, and to be designated Section 27A."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 27 of Chapter 157 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1902, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 27 and 28 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'Birds and Game,' and to re-enact the same with amendments," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows: Amendment to game law.

27. It shall not be lawful for any person in Caroline County to shoot, kill, catch or in any way entrap any woodcock in said county between the fifteenth day of January and the fourth day of July in each and every year; nor any sora, or water rail, between the fifteenth day of January and the fifteenth day of September in each and every year; nor any wild duck between the first day of April and fifteenth day of September in each and every year; nor any squirrel between the fifteenth day of January and the first day of September in each and Prohibitive seasons for catching or killing game.
