Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Marvland, That the County Commissioners of Washington County be and they are hereby authorized and directed, in their discretion, to enter into a contract with "The Washington County Hospital Association" whereby they shall contract to contribute annually in perpetuity a sum of two thousand dollars per annum for the care and maintenance of the hospital under the control and direction of the said "The Washington County Hospital Association."

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That for the purpose of carry-Levy and colling out the obligations which may be incurred under the provisions of the aforegoing section that the said County Commissioners of Washington County be and they are hereby authorized and directed, in their discretion, to levy and collect annually in perpetuity on the assessable property of said county a sum of money sufficient to meet the obligations to be incurred by the said County Commissioners of Washington County under the provisions of the aforegoing section.

> SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Wicomico County to issue bonds for the purpose of erecting a building in the town of Salisbury to be known as the "Wicomico County High School Building," for equipping and furnishing the same, to be used for the public schools of the said county, and to levy and collect taxes for the payment of the said bonds; and to authorize the purchase or condemnation of a lot for the same by the Board of School Commissioners of Wicomico County.

Issuance of bonds to build a high school.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the purpose of erecting a building on such lot as the Board of School Commissioners of Wicomico County may now own, purchase or condemn, and for the purpose of properly furnishing and equipping the said building the County
