

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be unlawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Garrett County, Maryland, to issue to any person or persons or corporation a license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Election Districts Nos. 6, 10 and 12, commonly known as Sang Run, Deer Park and Bittering Districts of Garrett County, Maryland.

CHAPTER 104.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 120 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1902, entitled "An Act to regulate the catching of crabs in the waters of Queen Anne's County."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Chapter 120 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1902, entitled "An Act to regulate the catching of crabs in the waters of Queen Anne's County," be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," under the new sub-title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," to be designated as Section 28A, and to follow Section 28.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and the same is hereby added to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," under the new sub-title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," to follow Section 28, and to be designated as Section 28A, and to read as follows:

28A. It shall be lawful for banks, bankers, trust companies and other banking institutions in the city of Hagerstown, Washington County, to close their doors for business at twelve o'clock noon on each and every Saturday in the year,
