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CHAPTER 131.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Howard County to pay claims of James F. Melvin, L. A. Rettaliata and N. W. Burton for printing and publishing notice of election.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Howard County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to pay to the following persons the following amounts for printing and publishing notices of election: James F. Melvin the sum of three hundred and sixty-eight dollars and twenty-five cents; to L. A. Rettaliata the sum of three hundred and three dollars and fifty-five cents; and N. W. Burton the sum of four hundred and eleven dollars and five cents; provided, however, that the said James F. Melvin, L. A. Rettaliata and N. W. Burton shall receive said amounts in full settlement of all claims they may have against the County Commissioners for all printing done for Howard County prior to November 3, 1903.

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CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to levy a sum, to be applied to the building of a school house in the fifth district of Baltimore County, at Arcadia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore County are hereby authorized and directed to levy on the assessable
