

Exchange. to such corporations, firms or individuals, and to make such examination and reports for the use and information of directors, officers or others concerned, or for any other lawful purpose; also to collect information of general, financial and commercial interest, and to make publication and distribution thereof, and to receive compensation for such services. The said corporation shall be authorized to purchase, acquire, hold and dispose of the stocks, bonds and other evidences of indebtedness of any corporation, domestic or foreign, and issue in exchange therefor its stocks, bonds or other obligations.

Its govern-  
ment. SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the said company hereby created shall have power to enact and adopt such rules, regulations and by-laws for the government and management of the affairs of said corporation as it may deem advantageous to the interests thereof; provided, the same be not contrary to the law of the land.

Right to  
amend Act. SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly reserves the right to repeal, alter or amend this Act at its pleasure.

State laws to  
control. SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That said company shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 109 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1892, and any supplements thereto and amendments thereof; and the liability of the stockholders thereof shall at all times be determined by the laws of this State in force at the time the said liability may attach.

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 150.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 14 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "Fish," to be known as Section 89A, and to follow Section 89.

Howard  
County. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an additional section be added to Article 14 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "Fish," to be known as Section 89A, and to follow Section 89, and to read as follows:

Protecting fish  
in its waters. 89A. No person shall place, throw or make use of in any of the waters of Howard County, except for bona fide engineering, milling or mining purposes, any dynamite or other explosive substance, or any lime, poison, acid, sawdust, shavings
