of Baltimore City; the said bequest of \$2,500 by the terms of the will to be paid free from the collateral inheritance tax; same to be paid by the estate of Miss Swan as in the will provided.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 158.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County to pay, in their discretion, to Thomas I. Wright, of said county, the sum of two hundred dollars, with interest from the 22d day of October, 1892, for money paid by him to the said Board for certain real estate.

Conveyance of property for school purposes.

WHEREAS, On the 18th day of September, 1880, Thomas I. Wright conveyed to the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County certain real estate located in Hurlock Election District of said county, in fee, for a nominal consideration, to be used for school purposes; and

Provision omitted.

WHEREAS, It was the understanding of the parties at the time of said conveyance that whenever said land should cease to be used for school purposes it should be conveved back to the said grantor for a nominal consideration, but this provision was erroneously omitted from the said deed; and

Failed to reconvey.

WHEREAS, In the year 1892 the said land, ceasing to be used for school purposes, was not reconveyed to the said Thomas I. Wright, but was sold at public sale to the highest bidder for the sum of two hundred dollars, the said Thomas I. Wright bidding in the same; now, therefore,

School Commissioners to refund pur-

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County be and they are hereby authorized, empowered chase money, and directed, in their discretion, to pay back to the said Thomas I. Wright, of Dorchester County, the sum of two hundred dollars, with interest from the 22d day of October, 1892, for the purchase money of land purchased by him from the said Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County.
