

and providing heating apparatus therefor, in the town of Cambridge, Dorchester County, Maryland, and to authorize and require the Board of County School Commissioners of said county to borrow money for the purpose of repairing and improving said building, building an addition thereto and providing heating apparatus therefor, by issuing bonds to be endorsed by the County Commissioners of Dorchester County, and authorizing said County Commissioners to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds.

To build an addition to a female seminary.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Edward G. Hopkins, George W. Woolford, Henry Lloyd, John G. Mills, Rigly T. Wright, Andrew J. Foble and William E. Woodrow, all of Cambridge, Dorchester County, Maryland, be and they are hereby appointed and constituted a building committee, to serve without pay, for the purpose of repairing and improving and building an addition to the Cambridge Female Seminary Building, located on Academy street, in said town of Cambridge, Maryland, and providing suitable and sufficient heating apparatus therefor; four of said committee shall constitute a quorum, and the concurrence of four of them shall be necessary for the decision of all questions which may arise in the discharge of their duties; and all vacancies occurring in said building committee, whether from death, refusal to act, resignation or otherwise, shall be filled by competent persons to be selected and appointed by the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County.

To fill vacancies on building committee.

Sealed proposals for the work to be performed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Building Committee shall as speedily as possible procure and adopt plans and specifications for repairing and improving said Female Seminary Building, and for building an addition thereto; and as soon as said plans and specifications are determined upon by them they shall invite sealed proposals by advertisement for a reasonable time for the construction and completion of said work, which proposals shall be sent in sealed envelopes in care of the School Treasurer of Dorchester County addressed to said committee, and shall be publicly opened on the day and at the hour named in said advertisement; said proposals shall set forth the amount of money for which the parties proposing will complete the work and building according to the specifications, and the time or times at which payment therefor shall
