

2. That in the event that the jury summoned by the acting coroner, as provided by the preceding section, may deem an autopsy necessary and shall order the same to be had, it shall be the duty of said physician to perform such autopsy, who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of twenty-five dollars, to be paid by the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County.

Ordering an autopsy to be made.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of an additional justice of the peace for the Twelfth Election District of Montgomery County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint an additional justice of the peace in and for the Twelfth Election District of Montgomery County.

Additional magistrate for Montgomery County.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT to amend Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Dorchester County," sub-title "Hurlock," and to add two additional sections thereto, to be known as Sections 333A and 333B.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Dorchester County," sub-title "Hurlock," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto two new sections to follow after Section 333, to be known as Sections 333A and 333B.

Amendment to Article 10.

333A. The said Commissioners shall have full power to provide for laying out, opening, extending, widening, straightening or closing up, in whole or in part, any street, lane or alley within the limits of the town which, in their opinion, the public welfare or convenience may require, to provide for ascertaining whether any and what amount in value of damages will be caused thereby, and what amount of benefit will

Granting Town Commissioners power to lay out, open, widen, etc., streets and lanes.
