

of compensation and prescribe the duties respectively of said bailiff and treasurer; all property within the limits of Westernport or that may have a situs there by reason of the residence of the owner therein, except as hereinafter provided, shall be taxed for municipal purposes, and the said taxes shall be due and payable within six months of the date of the levy, and the bailiff shall not be allowed for any insolvent or uncollectible taxes unless the same shall have been allowed him within eight months after the receipt of the warrant and list of the persons chargeable with said taxes, and the respective sums to be collected from each person; and said Mayor and Commissioners shall have power to appoint one or more assessors, as in their judgment may be required to assess all real and personal property and estate in said town at such times as they may deem necessary, and all vacancies occurring from death, removal, resignation or any other cause, whether in the office of Mayor or Commissioner of Westernport, or in any other office provided for in the town charter, shall, without delay, be filled by appointment by the Commissioners of Westernport.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 204.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of the town of Kensington, Montgomery County, to borrow money on the credit of said town for the purpose of constructing a system of water works, and sewerage, and electric lights, if the amount appropriated be sufficient, and to redeem all of the bonds of said town issued under previous Acts, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of the said town to repay the money borrowed and interest thereon, and to submit the same to a vote of the real property owners residents of said town.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of the town of Kensington, in the county of Montgomery, be and they are hereby authorized to construct a system of water works and sewerage (and electric lights, if the amount appropriated be sufficient,) for the use of said town, and to redeem all bonds of said town
