Refusal of Inspector to comply with Act.

SEC. 41. And be it enacted, That the Inspector of Plumbing shall comply with the requirements of this Act, and any neglect or refusal so to do shall subject him, upon conviction, to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each violation thereof.

Master plumber to be member of local Board of Health.

SEC. 42. And be it enacted, That a master plumber be appointed by the Mayor of each said incorporated city or town as a member of the present Board of Health, and that a master plumber be one of the Board of Health hereafter appointed from time to time, but in no case shall the Inspector of Plumbing be a member of the Board of Health.

SEC. 43. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Approved March 31, 1904.

CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Board of Police Commissioners of the City of Baltimore to pension Jacob Frey, formerly Marshal of Police of Baltimore City.

Pensioning a former Police Marshal. WHEREAS, Jacob Frey was a member of the police force of Baltimore City for more than thirty years of continuous and faithful service.

Money to be taken from the special fund. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore City be and they are hereby authorized and directed to pay to Jacob Frey, formerly Marshal of Police, out of the fund in the hands of the said Board of Police Commissioners known and accounted for as a special fund, the sum of seventy-five dollars per month for life, said payment or pension to be accounted from the first day of January, 1904.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 208.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 5 of Chapter 189 of the Acts of 1902, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 202 to 215 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Worcester County,' sub-title 'Pocomoke City.'"
