SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 211.

AN ACT to refund Joseph Muir a sum of money paid by him to the Comptroller of the Treasury of the State, and converted into the Treasury of the State, for license to dredge for oysters with the schooner Irene, which schooner was wrecked prior to its use under said license.

WHEREAS, Joseph Muir on the 8th day of October, 1903, procured license No. 63 from the Comptroller of the Treasury for the schooner Irene and four hands to dredge for oysters for the season ending March 15, 1904, paying therefor to said Comptroller the sum of forty-three dollars and five cents; and

WHEREAS, The schooner Irene was wrecked on the 16th day of October, 1903, the said schooner Irene not having been used at all for dredging of oysters during the said season; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasury of the State in favor of Joseph Muir, of Somerset County, for the sum of forty-three dollars and five cents heretofore recited, paid by him for unused license as aforesaid, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
