

in said election district, city or town on or after the first day of May next succeeding; provided, however, that any license then outstanding and unexpired shall continue for the time for which it was issued.

4B. That for the purpose of holding the special election for Salisbury Election District No. 9 and Delmar Election District No. 11, authorized by Section 1A of this Act, the Supervisors of Elections shall give ten days' notice of said election by publication in two newspapers published in Wicomico County, representing each of the political parties in said county, of the time and place of holding said election; that in the case of all elections thereafter held upon said question authorized by Section 2 of this Act, the same notice shall be given as required by the General Election Laws of this State; that the Supervisors of Election shall appoint judges and clerks of election in the same manner and of the same number as are required to be appointed at any election held under the General Election Laws of this State.

Notice to be given to electors.

18. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation, directly or indirectly, to sell or otherwise dispose of, by way of barter, within Pittsburg Election District No. 4, Parsons Election District No. 5, Dennis Election District No. 6, Trappe Election District No. 7, Nutters Election District No. 8, Sharptown Election District No. 10, Nanticoke Election District No. 12, Barren Creek Election District No. 1, of Wicomico County, Maryland, any spirituous, vinous, malt or fermented or other intoxicating liquors of any kind, medicated bitters or any compound of which alcohol is a chief or principal ingredient; and it shall also be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation within said election district to take orders for any such liquors, medicated bitters or alcoholic compound at any time under any pretenses, in any manner or for any purpose whatsoever; and if any person or persons, firm or corporation within the said election districts shall, directly or indirectly, sell or otherwise dispose of, by way of barter, any such liquors, medicated bitters or alcoholic compound, or shall therein take any order or orders therefor, then such person or persons, the members of such firm, and the directors, trustees or managers of such corporation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof in the Circuit Court for Wicomico County, or before any justice of the peace thereof, shall, for the first offense, be fined and pay a sum of not less than fifty dollars, or be confined in the county jail, or in the Maryland House of Correction, in the discretion of the court, for not less than three nor more than six
